



INGLEWOOD UPDATES

Baptist Housing's development permit application to revitalize the 58-year-old Inglewood Care Centre has been submitted to the District of West Vancouver for consideration. The aging 230-bed long-term care centre would be replaced with two new state-of-the-art care buildings in phase one for 240 residents. In the next phases, 72 additional private-pay care beds will be created along with 34 assisted living suites, 155 affordable rental housing suites for seniors and team members, and 200 independent living suites for seniors. The plan creates a "Continuum of Care" that enables seniors to live long-term on the same property in the kind of residence best suited to them.
