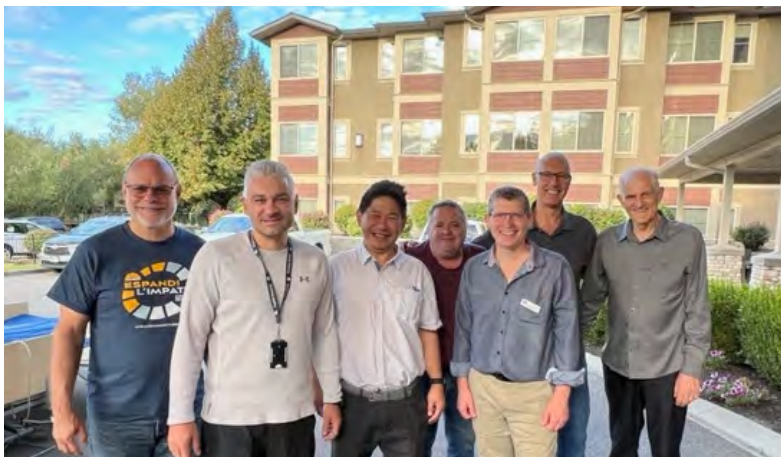




HAPPY CENTENARIAN'S DAY!
