Evergreen Baptist Campus of Care in White Rock has a long history of caring for seniors. The care campus includes long-term care, assisted living and affordable housing. The campus was founded in 1959 by members of the North American Baptist Conference Association of BC Churches. As their board looked to the future and considered how best to secure the long-term ministry of their campus a decision was made that resulted in Baptist Housing assuming transfer of the campus.

As a non-profit faith based organization, Baptist Housing has an equally rich history of serving seniors in BC establishing its first residence in Vancouver in 1964. Today, the organization has 18 senior living communities in the Lower Mainland, Victoria and Kelowna that are home to over 2,500 seniors.
